
For the first time, both organisations are joining forces to organise a highly interactive programme to provide a concise review of clinical knowledge and an outline of the essential professional skills for candidate assessment and longitudinal support for mechanical circulatory support patients of all ages.

The programme has been designed by our international experts, Prof. Stephan Ensminger, Lübeck, Germany and Prof. Martin Schweiger Zürich, Switzerland.

The course should serve programs providing mechanical circulatory support with a tool to review their standards of care, develop protocols, and implement guidelines established in managing mechanical circulatory support patients. An additional focus will be laid on career perspectives and advice in MCS to create a more diverse group of clinicians. This course is designed at the level of clinicians and allied health professionals who are in the early stages of their careers. This course would also benefit those who are part of a new program or desire a comprehensive foundational review. The information presented will cover core competencies and is intended to provide a strong foundation for the overarching principles of mechanical circulatory support.
