At the University Medical Center Groningen (UMCG) all forms of organ transplantation are performed: heart, liver, lung, kidney, pancreas, small bowel and stem cell. All transplantation programs work together in the UMCG Transplant Center. They reinforce each other in overlapping areas by combining their knowledge and experience.

Curriculum

The curriculum consists of the following subjects: physiology, biomechanics and organ donation (fundamental knowledge), liver, lung, heart and kidney perfusion and normothermic regional perfusion (specific knowledge).

Subject specific international experts will make sure you are state-of-the-art informed, through place- and time independent education, online discussion sessions and hands on training.

Each subject is summarized by a general learning objective and will be assessed. If all assessments are passed, you will receive a diploma.

Duration and venue

This course has a duration of approximately 12 months and consists of:

- 215 theoretical study hours (average, depending on prior knowledge)
- 14 live online course days
- 3 hands on training weeks at our state-of-the-art skills center, equipped to realistically imitate practice

Targetgroup

Those who aspire the position of organ perfusionist or those who already work as one. The official language during the course is English. Required prior education:

- Bachelor of medicine / technical medicine / clinical technology or
- (CZO-)diploma of clinical perfusionist.
