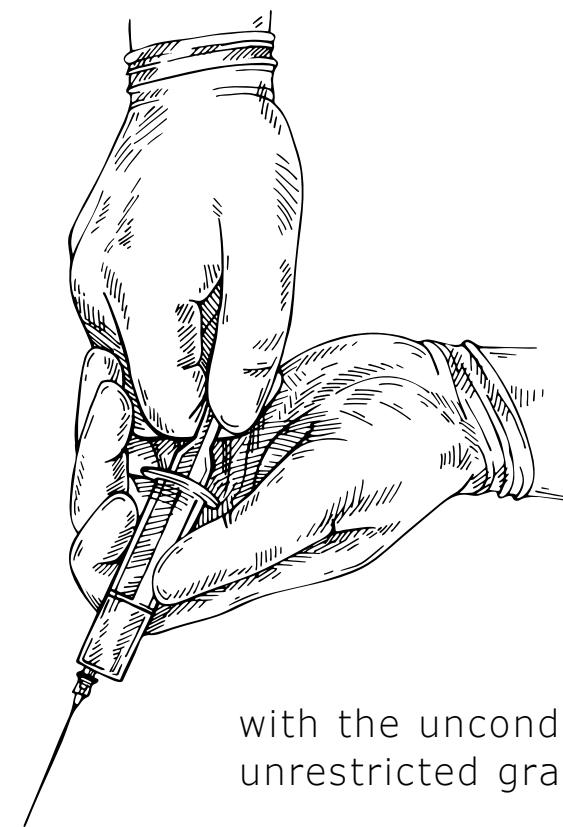
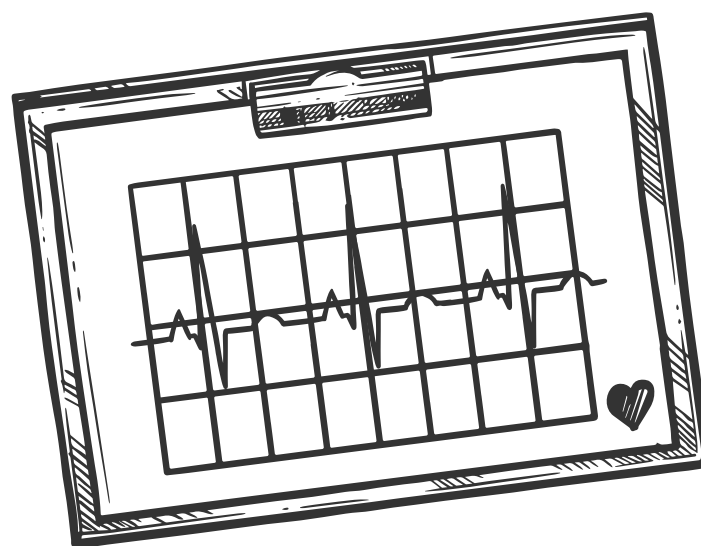




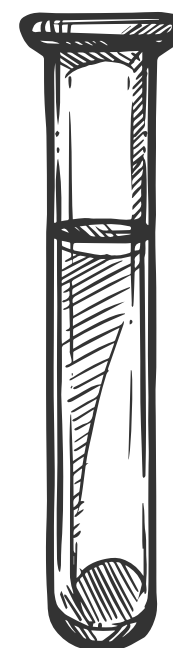
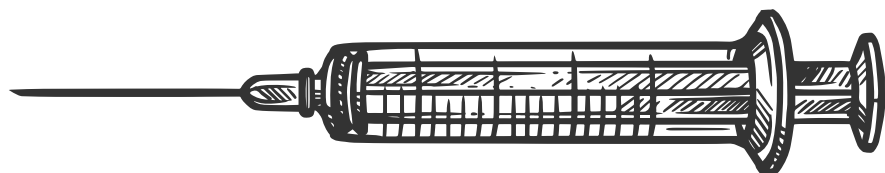
# What is a kidney transplant?

A surgery to replace a diseased kidney with a healthy one from a living or deceased donor



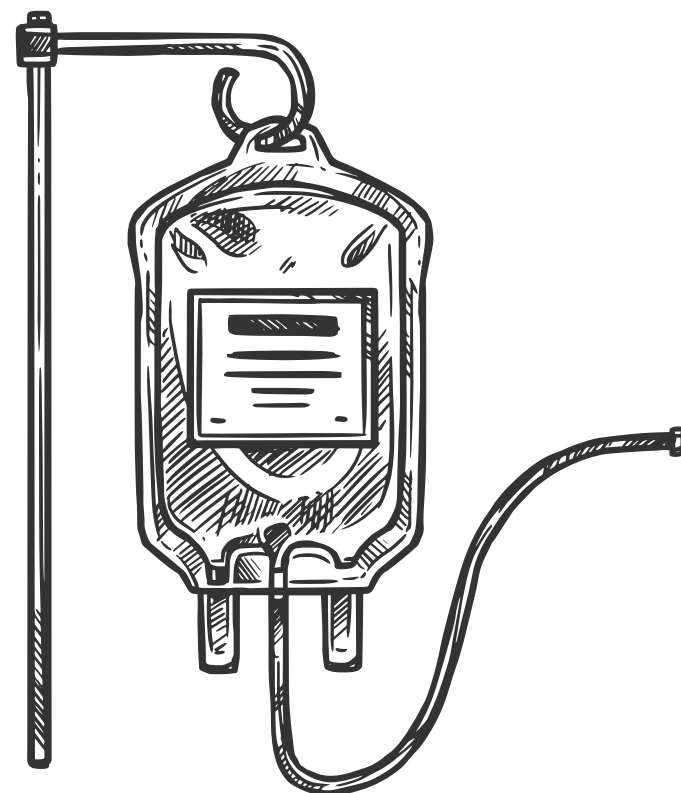
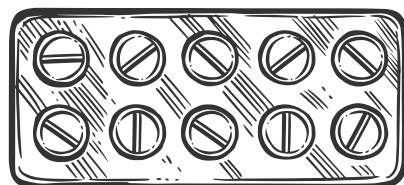
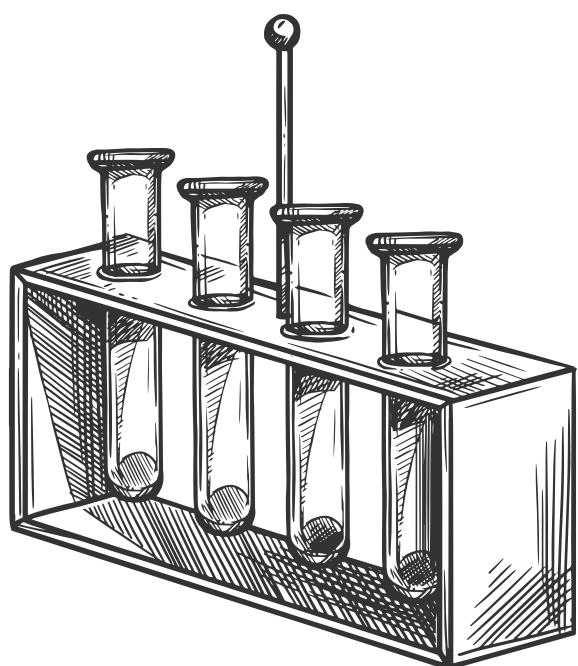

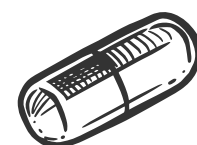




# The first step to a kidney transplant

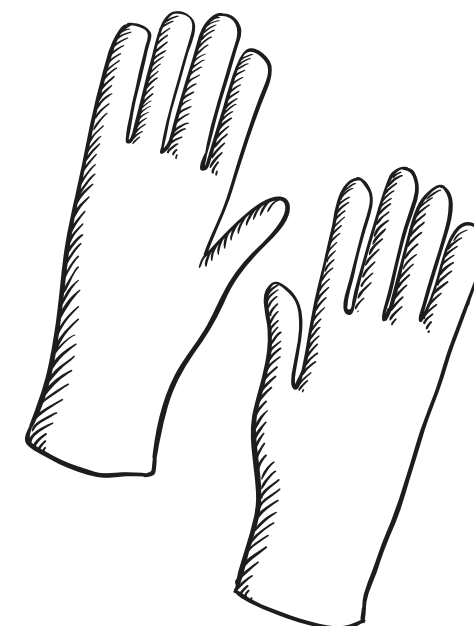
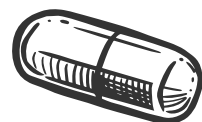
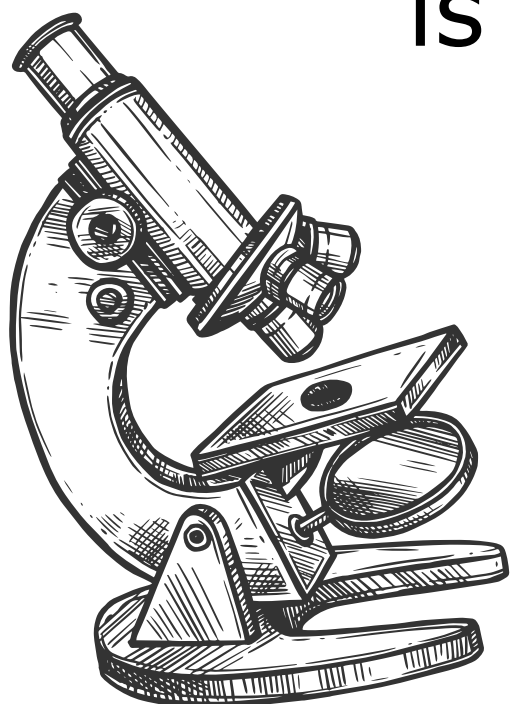


## Tests



To check for the presence of any diseases incompatible with the transplant or the drugs to be taken.

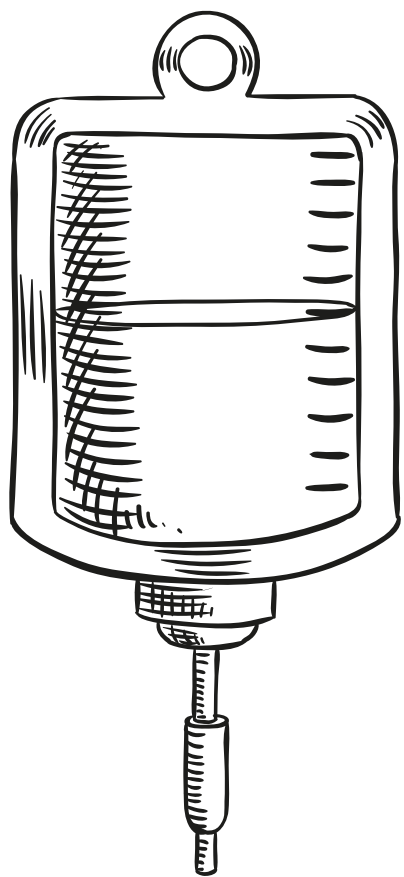
This will determine whether a patient is suitable and can be inserted in the waiting list

## Matching with the donor

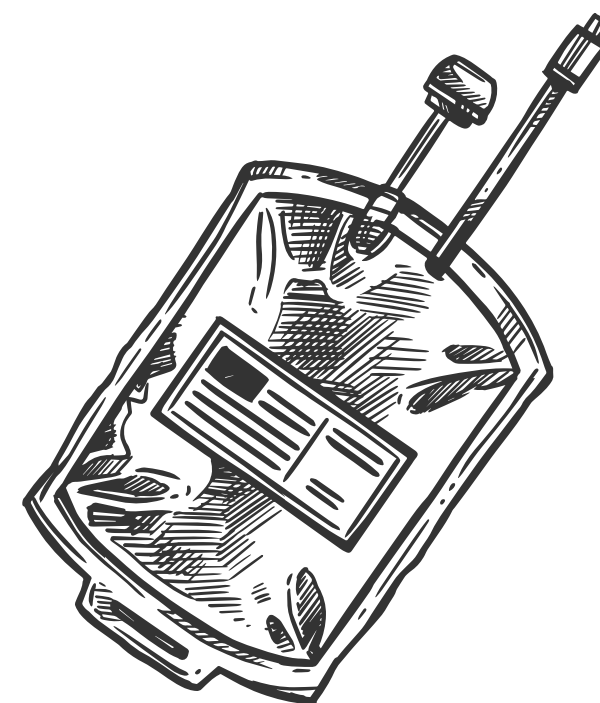
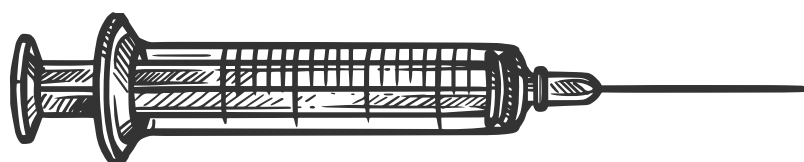
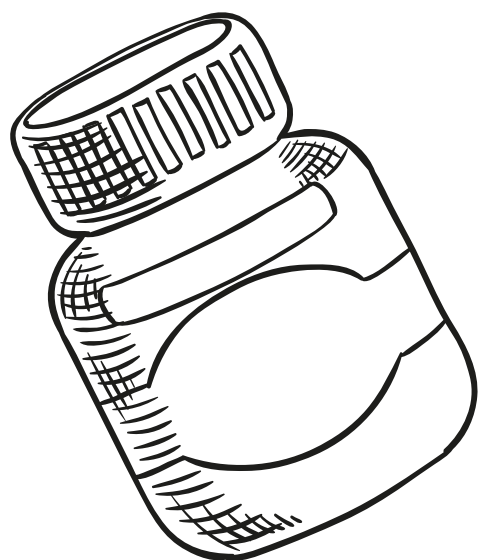


Once on the waiting list,

and blood type.

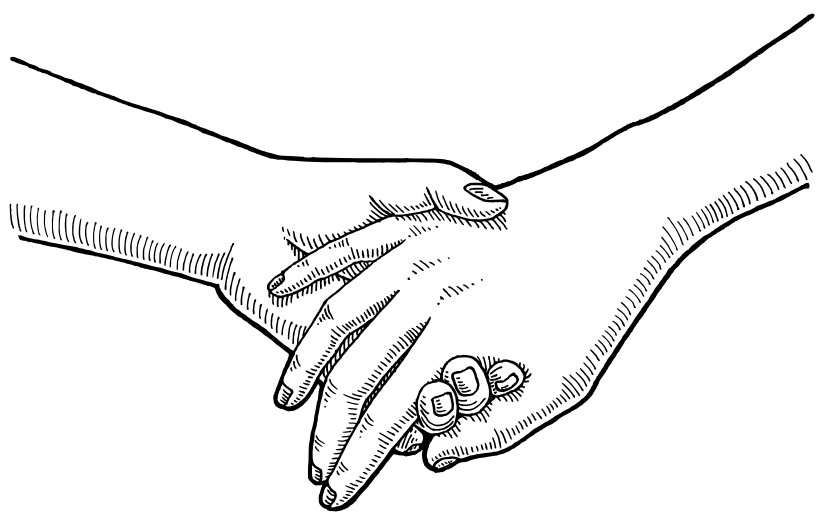
