 - When collecting additional information needed for organizing events
- Professional details updates
 - When members or users provide or update their professional information
- Optional background information
 - When individuals provide additional background information for better event organization

Communication and Marketing	Consent (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR) or legitimate interests (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR)
Compliance with Legal Obligations	Legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) GDPR)

If any of the above purposes would need to include the processing of special categories of personal data (such as health data), ESOT would only process such data based on an applicable legal exemption as set out in Article 9 (2) of the GDPR.

7. Data Retention

We will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it. To determine the appropriate retention period, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure, the purposes for which we process the data, and applicable legal requirements.
